Parish Council Meeting
15th January 2018**

Negotiations regarding the acquisition of The Croft Car Park have progressed well with Taylor Wimpy. We are now waiting for clarification of final terms that Taylor Wimpy will accept with regards to the Parish Council's professional fees in this matter.

I have had a meeting on 9th January 2018 with Ollie Schofield and Tony Perks together with Councillor Stephen Thirlwell about the Prince Harry Road Carpark. It has been agreed that they will now draft a report in preparation for a District Council cabinet meeting scheduled for 9th April 2018 to seek approval in principal of granting the Parish Council a long lease at a peppercorn rent with the right for the Parish Council to sub-let.

The condition is that the Parish Council have under their control or influence the Northern Car Park, The Prince Harry Road Car Park and the Croft Car Park so that there is a management strategy in place surrounding all three car parks and the District Council would like sight of a proposal from the Parish Council to how this arrangement will be delivered across the three Car Parks in Henley.
