

## **Traffic & Parking Working Party Report as at 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

Work is progressing with negotiations with LPS Ltd in accordance with the resolution part on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018. Work is also progressing in accordance to the resolution past on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018 with regard to solicitors now receiving confirmation that Taylor Wimpy has put their solicitors in funds, Evershed Sunderland. The solicitors acting for the Joint Parish Council, Thomas Guise of Studley, should be receiving from Thomas Jenkins of Evershed Sunderland undertaking for the legal costs together with all draft papers and contract shortly. Councillor Stephen Thirlwell has also reported that the Stratford-upon-Avon District Councils cabinet has authorised the Head of Services and himself and one portfolio holder to take forward the discussions for the JCP to take over the lease of Prince Harry Road Car Park in accordance with the terms approved in the resolution passed by JCP on 19<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

The Traffic & Parking Working Party met on Wednesday 13.06.18 to further discuss the negotiations with LPS Ltd and the charges on the Car Park to be levied and how this would balance with the Northern Car Park charging arrangements.
