REPORT OF THE CCTV FORUM MEETING 06.11.18.

Attended by Peter Crathorne

1. CCTV Incidents and updates. (See attached) Reported that Claverdon were thinking about installing their own CCTV system.
The following are extracts from the full incident report for Henley to November 6th 2019
 - 1.1. CCTV monitor a stolen vehicle taken in a car travelling throughout the street in the direction of Birmingham.
 - 1.2. CCTV observes two males acting suspiciously
 - 1.3. CCTV spots and elderly high risk missing person on Henley High Street
 - 1.4. Observations made on I suspect male loitering outside a closed shop.
2. Crime Trends. (See see attached) overall Crime is down but Rural burglary is up. Small village store being targeted. Discussed the value of Crime Defence WhatsAps Groups. While communication about suspicious activity is improved it also raises the fear of crime and number of false alarms increase.
3. Reported the expected large numbers for the WWI Memorial Event on 11.11.18. Noted by the police.
4. CCTV Scheme Upgrade. Cost of the Scheme is well above the £465,000 available SDC is too consider whether to add to the pot. Surveys underway. Will be a fibre system as WiFi is not robust enough. No date yet but completion probably by 2021.
5. CCTV Funding 4 year agreement from April 2019. Here will be an increase no figures yet. These were promised before the end of the year. Present cost £1926 per annum.
