

Traffic and Parking Working Party ~ Report for JPC Meeting 20th June.

The working party meet on the 23rd. May and discussed the Office survey results and the letter to be delivered to all the restaurants in the town to see if they would be interested in joining a scheme that would see office car parks at night that are empty being available to diners on a very controlled basis.

We have also heard from the Doctors practice manager about the parking concerns in the public car park at the end of Prince Harry Road.

The plan to take under the control of The JPC the Croft and Prince Harry Road car parks is advancing, but can only really be taken forward if there is an approved comprehensive Town Parking solution/ scheme.

Discussion have taken place with Network Rail and Malcolm Holmes Programme Director, West Midlands Rail, I am still waiting to hear from Tunde Olatunji of Centro, who seem to run all the car parks at Railway Stations in this areas. I wish to ascertain they believe that Henley Station need at least a 40 car park over and above what is currently available and what funds may be on offer if any to help provide such a facility.

A presentation is being collated (peter crawthorne) that will be presented to the Town at a full open meeting, containing our Working party's comprehensive proposals that if given general support will go forward into the Draft Neighbour Hood plan that will I understand be voted on in The Towns referendum February/March next yeas.
