SDC Covid Cases -

Here in the Stratford District our numbers are now at 50 per 100,000, Warwick is 69, North Warwickshire at 100, Solihull 54 & Redditch 141.

Henley & Claverdon in the week ending 24th Feb had less than 3 cases according to the NHS Digital website.

Book a Test

The over 56's can now book their jab online now – go to <u>https://www.nhs.uk/book-a-coronavirus-vaccination/do-you-have-an-nhs-number</u>

As you might be able to guess from the URL – you will need your NHS number. This should be any correspondence that you have received from your GP (a 10 figure number).

Business Grants update

The Government has just announced further grants – Kick Start – we have not received guidance yet on this but will notify you as soon as we do.

Previous grants have been sent out including a further 6 week payment covering the period from 16th Feb to 31st March.

This brings the total paid out to local businesses to £16 million since the November lockdown and over £48m since the pandemic started.

The Budget Last Week

Budget headlines referring to the new Business Rates offering, if this turns out to be the case when we get the guidance in the coming days, it looks like businesses will pay nothing from April to June then six months where rates will be discounted to two-thirds of the normal charge followed by 3 months at the full amount due. As yet we have not been sent the details or software yet – when we do we will be able calculate / bill / administer & collect business rates based on this scenario. We would normally be issuing Business Rate bills this weekend – this will be delayed now until we are in position to produce bills based on this new proposal.

Other Council News

Super District

Update on exploring the creation of a South Warwickshire 'Super District' – This was passed by SDC almost unanimously (only 1 against) and at WDC all for apart from 5 abstaining.

Green Bins

We have had over 30,000 sign up ! This comes into effect in April. Early Bird has finished but if you forgot then ask and you might still get it...

New Political Map

The Local Government Boundary Commission has decided that the number of councillors in Stratfordon-Avon should be 41 (currently 36) in order to give greater representations to members of the District.

The Commission is interested in views on which communities should be part of the same ward. What facilities do people share, such as parks, leisure centres or schools and shopping areas? What issues do neighbouring communities face that they have in common, such as high numbers of visitors or heavy traffic? Have there been new housing or commercial developments that have changed the focus of communities? And are there roads, rivers, railways or other features that people believe form strong boundaries between neighbourhoods?
