Thank you for your email, I have asked our legal team for their advice around this issue. I may or may not receive this by 9<sup>th</sup> May. Please note that the Highway Code has recently been updated and does appear to put the onus on the person using the charge point, I have included the relevant extract below;

### Using an electric vehicle charge point

For the first time, the code includes guidance about using electric vehicle charging points.

When using one, people should:

- park close to the charge point and avoid creating a trip hazard for people walking from trailing cables
- display a warning sign if you can
- return charging cables and connectors neatly to minimise the danger to other people and avoid creating an obstacle for other road users
