# **Fake News**

I would like to address some mis-information being distributed regarding the District Councils handling of finances. The District Council have falsely been accused of wasting £320,000 of tax payers money on the merger exercise with WDC !

As I have previously reported, even though the merger did not happen it still generated both Councils a considerable amount of savings - a total of £572,000 in year 1 and will continue to do so for at least the next few years. SDC are still running a number of joint projects with WDC – for example on waste contracts, SWLP and Legals.

SDC's administrative costs for the merger exercise came to a total of £160,000 but our share of the savings is £ 271,000 annually – this meant a net saving in savings £109,000 in year 1 alone and roughly £250,000 ongoing.

It is important to point out that these figures are in the public domain and are a matter of record.
