Whilst there may be occasions, due to operational sensitivities, where this will be the case, for the majority of incidents I will categorically state that this is not the case. For various reasons it is unfortunately not possible or practical for us to share all of the incidents that occur within the area within this report. The incidents detailed on this report are shared predominantly for two reasons; firstly, where an incident has occurred, and witnesses may be sought and secondly where there is a need to inform residents of any crime trends to allow for residents to be alert and take any crime prevention measures necessary to avoid becoming a victim themselves.
