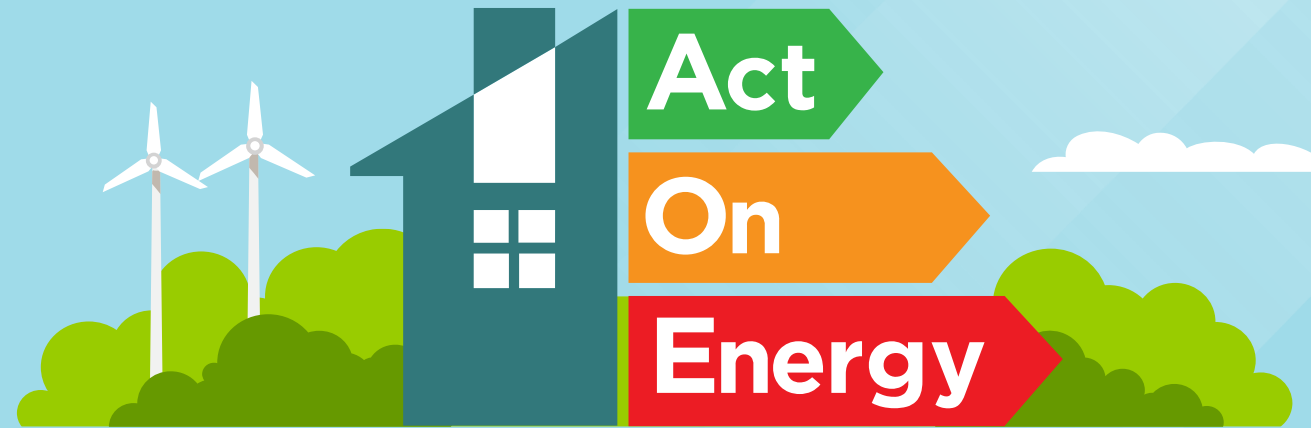

ELIGIBILITY

CUSTOMER MUST SATISFY ALL 4 CRITERIA:

- | Household in the district of Stratford
- | Gross household income below £30K per year
- | Vulnerability in household
- | No savings

VULNERABILITY

- Long term diagnosed and treated health conditions e.g., COPD
- Self-employed who have been unable to work/ income impacted by Covid 19
- Households with unmanageable debt
- Recently made redundant
- Pregnant
- Disabled and in receipt of DLA or PIP
- In receipt of free school meals
- Other vulnerabilities disclosed by household's not on the list but accepted at AOE's discretion

Financial help towards current energy costs – one off payment to an energy account only of provision of fuel vouchers

Utility types:

- ▶ Electricity or
- ▶ Gas

Amount:

- ▶ Couples & singles
- ▶ Adult only households =
£300 payment direct to energy supplier or 6 x £49 Fuel Vouchers
codes for pre-payment key & card
- ▶ Families
- ▶ under 18s in household =
£500 payment direct to energy supplier or 9 x £49 Fuel Vouchers
codes for pre-payment key & card

HOW TO REFER RESIDENTS

Online expression of interest form

- Applicants can be identified by Act on Energy's complex case worker as well as by the recognised referral partners who will assist where needed and apply on behalf of a client using the online form verifying the client's criteria is eligible for the support.
- The client's energy supplier and energy account details together with their Council Tax number will be required upon application. This will need to be sourced by the referrer.
- Householders can also apply themselves online.
