NEW "WELCOME TO HENLEY SIGN"

Design concept and measurements in progress. I note that Claverdon have used the same approach for their welcome sign, utilising an existing sign for support, so a precedent has been set. Will continue with design and approvals and report back at October meeting.

BIN SURVEY

Please see attached report, the idea is to clean / repair / renovate where possible, however I seek for the approval for 2 new bins to replace unsightly bins at a cost of no more than £600. If approved, I will work with Colin on the renovation and replacement bin project.
