Clerk's Note: In addition to Gary Kirk's update, there were a small number of comments raised by other attendees, this is summarised in brief text rather than verbatim hereunder:

Gary Kirk commended the Joint Parish Council (JPC) and the Advisory Panel (AP) for their rapid progress. He confirmed that the AECOM online meetings were now completed and site visits to Henley were scheduled. When the AECOM reports are forthcoming, Gary offered to meet with theme groups to discuss the proposals put forward.

He suggested that now is an opportune time to engage with prospective landowners to understand any plans they may have for their plots. He also reiterated that Stratford District Council (SDC) would eventually set a housing allocation for Henley, and the JPC would need to work with the provided figures.

At that stage, the AP would assess site suitability. Questions from the audience were raised regarding affordable housing.

Cllr Rice provided further details, stating that SDC's housing allocation for the district would be 1,278 dwellings per year for the next 20 years, with the figures expected to be published by Christmas this year. He REITERATED that numbers for Henley were not available yet.

Richard Clark added that an email from George Cowcher had assured him that any housing allocation would be supported by adequate infrastructure.

In conclusion, the JPC and AP will need to await SDC's allocation figures before making final decisions. The Clerk will send invitations to landowners for a meeting, proposed for mid to late November 2024.
